Erectile Dysfunction

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
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Low Testosterone/ Andropause

Other Sexual Health Issues We Treat

Peyronie's Disease (PD)

Curvature of the penis due to scar tissue effects almost 10% of men. Most experience significant improvement without surgery, but **early diagnosis** and treatment by an experienced urologist is critical to achieving successful results. Premature Ejaculation (PE)

Roughly 20-30% of men suffer from premature ejaculation. It's important to keep in mind that even when PE cannot be cured, it can be managed successfully. We can determine the cause and figure out which approaches work best for you. **Learn more about PE**

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Male Infertility

In 60% of cases, a male factor contributes to infertility.

If you and your partner are struggling to start a family, Maze can help. Male infertility is a complicated topic, but a specialist can offer a variety of treatment options.

The first step is to conduct a <u>Semen Analysis</u> which helps determine whether there is a male factor involved in a couple's infertility. This non-invasive test checks the quantity and quality of sperm and can help determine whether the problem is related to sperm production or delivery.

If the semen analysis indicates <u>azoospermia</u>, or no sperm in the ejaculate, additional options may be available. **Over 44% of men diagnosed with azoospermia will have small numbers of sperm in their ejaculate.** If it's believed that sperm might indeed exist, one of the following advanced reproductive techniques may be recommended:

Extended Sperm Search & Microfreeze (ESSM)

ESSM is a revolutionary procedure that may be able to find small numbers of sperm through advanced processing techniques. A specially trained andrologist inspects an entire semen specimen in minute amounts and if

isolated sperm are found, they are frozen in a miniscule quantity of fluid so they can be easily found when needed for insertion into an egg. **Learn more**

Sperm Mapping

Sperm Mapping will determine if there are sperm producing areas in the testes. This test is useful because different areas of the testes have different patterns of sperm production. In 43-68% of azoospermic men, there are a small number of sperm that have been produced in the testes but do not reach the semen. If sperm are found, the couple can proceed with IVF and an open sperm retrieval procedure (micro-TESE).

Male Infertility – Other Causes

The semen analysis may also reveal other issues causing infertility, such as a varicocele or blockage, which are completely treatable by a specialist.

Varicocele

Similar to "varicose veins" in the legs, varicoceles refers to a dilated (enlarged) group of veins, but in the scrotum. There is one best way to repair a varicocele: the microscopic sub-inguinal varicocelectomy with ultrasound guidance, which can only be performed by a urologist specializing in fertility and microsurgery such as Dr. Michael Werner. **Learn more**

Epididymal Obstruction

An obstruction can form in the epididymis, a long, coiled tube located on the back of the testis, that prevents sperm from getting into the ejaculate. In most cases, the obstruction can be repaired, or the sperm can be extracted from the testes for IVF. **Learn more**














Vasectomy














Sperm Banking

- Undergoing a procedure, such as prostate surgery
- Taking medications that will affect sperm production, such as chemotherapy
- · Having a medical condition which can impact their ability to ejaculate, such as MS or diabetes
- Undergoing a vasectomy, yet want to have the option
- · Wanting to delay fatherhood until later in life


